Contestants must be 4 years old and no older than 18 years old as of June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016. All contestants must return completed application form with a wallet sized Head Shot {PICTURES MUST NOT BE BIGGER THAN 5 X 7 INCHES / WALLET SIZE A MUST} which will not be returned. Little & Teen Miss Colonial Days contestants will have On-Stage only interviews and will be judged in the same areas as the Tiny & Mini Colonial Days.

MISS COLONIAL QUEEN {16-18} contestants will have private interviews at The First Heritage Federal Credit Union located in Union Square at 3:45pm. Then attend the Pageant at 5:30pm for the 6:00pm start and be judged with on stage interviews and the same areas as all other categories.

2. Short essay that is no longer than 500 words on a topic of local and/or national concern that must be typewritten and will be judged by independent evaluators.
3. Poise and the ability to express yourself. You will introduce yourself and give a brief summary of your essay to last approx. 60 seconds.
4. Composure/Appearance/Attire.
5. On-Stage interview with the MC.
